- If your inquiry involves an agency that uses an identifying case or file number, have that ready.
- Be sure to record the name and title of person you talk to and confirm their phone numbers in your notes.
- Keep your notes together on all of your contacts to each agency so that you can supply information when you make follow up calls.

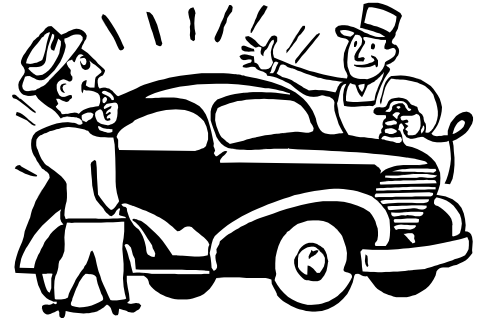

WHAT TO WEAR

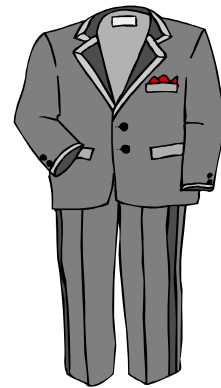
The knack of knowing what to wear, takes the **NAC!!!** This sounds mysterious... but it's very simple if you have the **NAC!** The **NAC** is as simple as this – you must be **Neat, Appropriate and Clean.**

- Pick out your outfit ahead of time, with plenty of time to try it on, get it cleaned, ironed, etc.
- Your best bet is to observe what others working in the office wear to work.
- A great time to do this is when you first come in to inquire about openings, pick up and application, etc.
- Make sure that you are not basing your attire on what people wear to work on a Friday. (Fridays are typically casual dress days at many companies.)
- Once you know what is expected of your attire at work, dress up a notch higher than that for your interview.

GENERAL TIPS ABOUT WHAT TO WEAR TO YOUR INTERVIEW:

- **DON'T**

- Dress too flashy, with too bright colors
- Wear too much jewelry
- Wear too much cologne/perfume
- Have any visible tattoos (if you do, cover them!)
- Wear too much Makeup
- Have a wild Hairstyle and color
- Wear dirty or wrinkled clothing
- Have Highly visible skin piercing



- **DO'S**

- Dress With conservative, dark colors
- Navy blue, black, or tan work best
- Smell freshly clean (shower before interview)
- If you do wear makeup, keep it subtle
- Have your hair brushed, styled neatly and kept away from your face
- If appropriate, make sure shirt is tucked in
- Clothing should be clean neatly pressed (ironed)

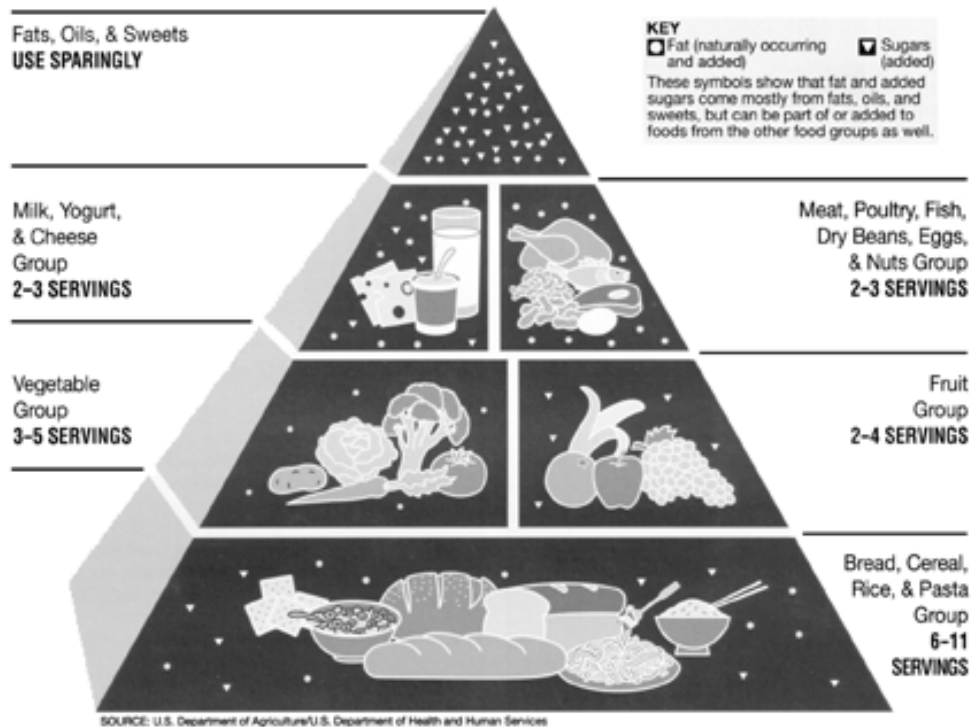

Step Eleven:

To obtain identification, follow these steps:

1. Go to the local Health Department in (Hillsboro) Jefferson County and apply for a birth certificate. (Missouri births only please.)
2. Take your birth certificate and go to the Social Security Office in Jefferson County and get a print of your social security number.
3. Take your birth certificate and your social security number along with proof of address and go to the License Bureau in Jefferson County and apply for an ID card.
4. Once you have all three, you will need to go back to the Social Security Office and apply for your Social Security Card.
5. Remember to take all documents with you!
